The service is staffed by experienced practitioners and teacher trainers offering specialist advice on all aspects of working in the lifelong learning sector. The service also includes the National Reference Point for Skills for Life professional development.

Speak to an adviser about

- The qualifications you'll need and what it's like to be a teacher, tutor or trainer
- Teacher training and continuing professional development
- The reform of Initial Teacher / Tutor / Trainer Education (ITTTE) from September 2007
- Continuing professional development in the areas of Adult Literacy, Numeracy and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
- The General Professional Recognition Learning and Skills (GPRLS) scheme which provides a route for existing practitioners to be recognised as teaching professionals
- The Tariff of Legacy ITT Qualifications giving information on how existing qualifications map to the new standards
- **Financial incentives such as:**
 - £4,000 Golden Hellos and Training Bursaries of £6,000 and £9,000 for those teaching shortage subjects
 - Key worker living property purchase scheme
 - Teaching in colleges and adult, work and community-based provision
